

Heard for Georgia Statement on District 68 Priorities

Courtney Heard Announces a District 68 Agenda Focused on Housing Stability, School Funding, and Accountability

Heard for Georgia today released a campaign statement outlining Courtney Heard's top priorities for Georgia House District 68: keeping families in their homes, fully funding public education, expanding healthcare access, and delivering accountable representation that responds to the real pressures families face every day.

"The people of District 68 deserve a representative who shows up, tells the truth, and fights for working families from day one," said Courtney Heard. "This campaign is about practical solutions that protect homeowners, strengthen schools, lower healthcare costs, and make sure economic growth actually reaches the people who live here."

The statement highlights four immediate priorities for the Georgia House:

- 1. Housing stability and homeowner protection.** Heard will push for stronger anti-displacement tools, property-tax relief for long-time residents, and HOA reforms that bring transparency, fair elections, and real accountability to homeowner associations.
- 2. Public education funding.** Heard supports a \$55,000 minimum starting salary for Georgia teachers and a full re-evaluation of the QBE funding formula so District 68 students receive the support they deserve.
- 3. Healthcare access.** Heard will fight for full Medicaid expansion, stronger maternal-health investment, and community-based healthcare infrastructure that brings care closer to District 68 families.
- 4. Responsive representation.** Heard says voters should expect a representative who remains visible after Election Day and treats service as an obligation, not a

slogan.

Heard, a U.S. Navy veteran and community advocate, said the campaign's message is rooted in conversations with residents across District 68 who want practical leadership and measurable results.

“This is not a campaign built around empty branding,” Heard said. “It is a commitment to bring urgency, honesty, and follow-through to the Capitol on behalf of every family in District 68.”
